Technical Specs

SCENERY and IN/ OUT times

FULL SET OPTION

- The full show of HAT as seen in the video requires a space of minimum 6.5 meters wide, 4 meters deep and 2.5 meters high.
- Set-up and tear-down are about 1 hour each, depending on location of parking dock and distance from stage.
- For a faster set-up and/or tear-down, we can preset off-stage.

NO-SET OPTION

- HAT is a completely adaptable show. We can play it without our scenery, **provided that there is** a hidden crossover from one side of the stage to the other.
- Set-up and tear-down will depend on the scene. If we have pictures and description of your space ahed of time and can avoid last-minute planning, set-up and tear-down times will be minimal.

LIGHTING

The lighting for HAT is also adaptable. The show takes place over the course of 1 day, so the lights basically go on in the beginning and go off at the end.

However, if your theatre or space offers a more complete lighting system, we would like to use a few color changes. We can organise this with your technician in advance.

1 electrical outlet, 220 v , is needed either SR or SL

SOUND

Sound is very important to our show, as there are no words, but only music. The music runs throughout the show, and is what contains our cues. That said, a sound system is necessary.

We travel with a MACBOOK. We use a 3/8 sound cable with 1/4 adapter. . We will need to be able to plug into your system with one of these options.

If you do not have a sound system, we will need to make some sort of arrangements. We can travel with our own sound system only if we are traveling with our car.

STAFF

We travel with our own sound person, who will operate the show (or cue your own operator). We will need a sound technician or someone familiar with your system to help our technician set up.

We will need a lighting technician, or someone to explain your system to our sound person and he can operate it in addition to the sound.
